EDUCATION UPDATE

2022 HAS BEEN ANOTHER DIFFICULT YEAR FOR OUR PUBLIC SCHOOLS FACING FUNDING SHORTFALLS, TEACHER SHORTAGES AND BROKEN ELECTION PROMISES.

In the lead up to the June Budget, we were joined by NSW Shadow Education Minister and Deputy Leader of the Opposition, Prue Car, MP for another online Community Town Hall to discuss the issues facing our education system today. We heard from our public school parents and teachers firsthand about:

- Chronic teacher shortages that have left our public schools with combined classes,
- 6 month wait periods to see a school counsellor,
- Parents being asked to donate soap during the pandemic,
- The need for coeducation high school options.

Thank you to all who joined us for this important conversation.

The 2022-23 NSW Budget once again shows that the NSW Government has failed to deliver funding for urgently needed major upgrades to Randwick Girls and Randwick Boys. More than 4 years on and the proposed upgrades are yet to progress past the planning phase, with budget papers showing that the Government still doesn't even have an estimated start or end date.

Our ongoing teacher shortage across NSW has recently become the subject of an Upper House

Inquiry in the NSW Parliament. Thank you to all of those in our community who made submissions. Your contributions will go a long way to ensuring our schools can remain fully staffed with adequate pay and conditions for our amazing educators. SAVE OUR BUSES

ON APRIL 4TH THIS YEAR OUR REGION 9 BUSES WERE OFFICIALLY PRIVATISED. REST ASSURED THAT THE CAMPAIGN TO SAVE OUR BUSES IS FAR FROM OVER.

Through fierce grassroots campaigning, we were able to save the 373 and secure an Upper House Inquiry into Bus Privatisations. A massive win for our campaign that showed our tireless efforts organising petitions, rallies, and media attention were starting to have some effect.

Whilst the Inquiry is yet to release their full findings, a preliminary report found that 75% of respondents are dissatisfied with their now privatised bus services and 82% are more likely to use their car.

We have now launched community consultation to ensure that you can **HAVE** YOUR SAY ON PUBLIC TRANSPORT in our area. This will shape our transportation priorities for the future.
